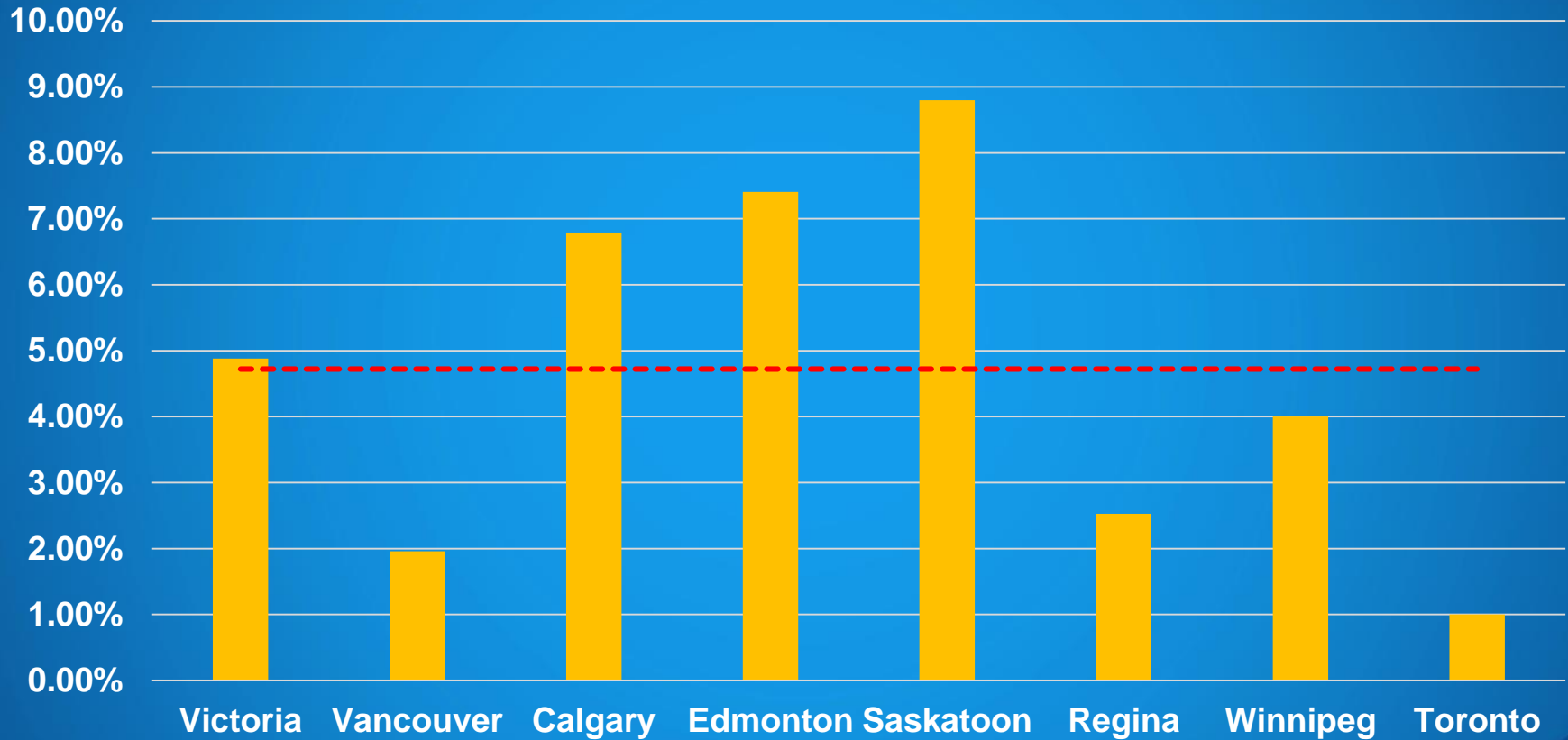
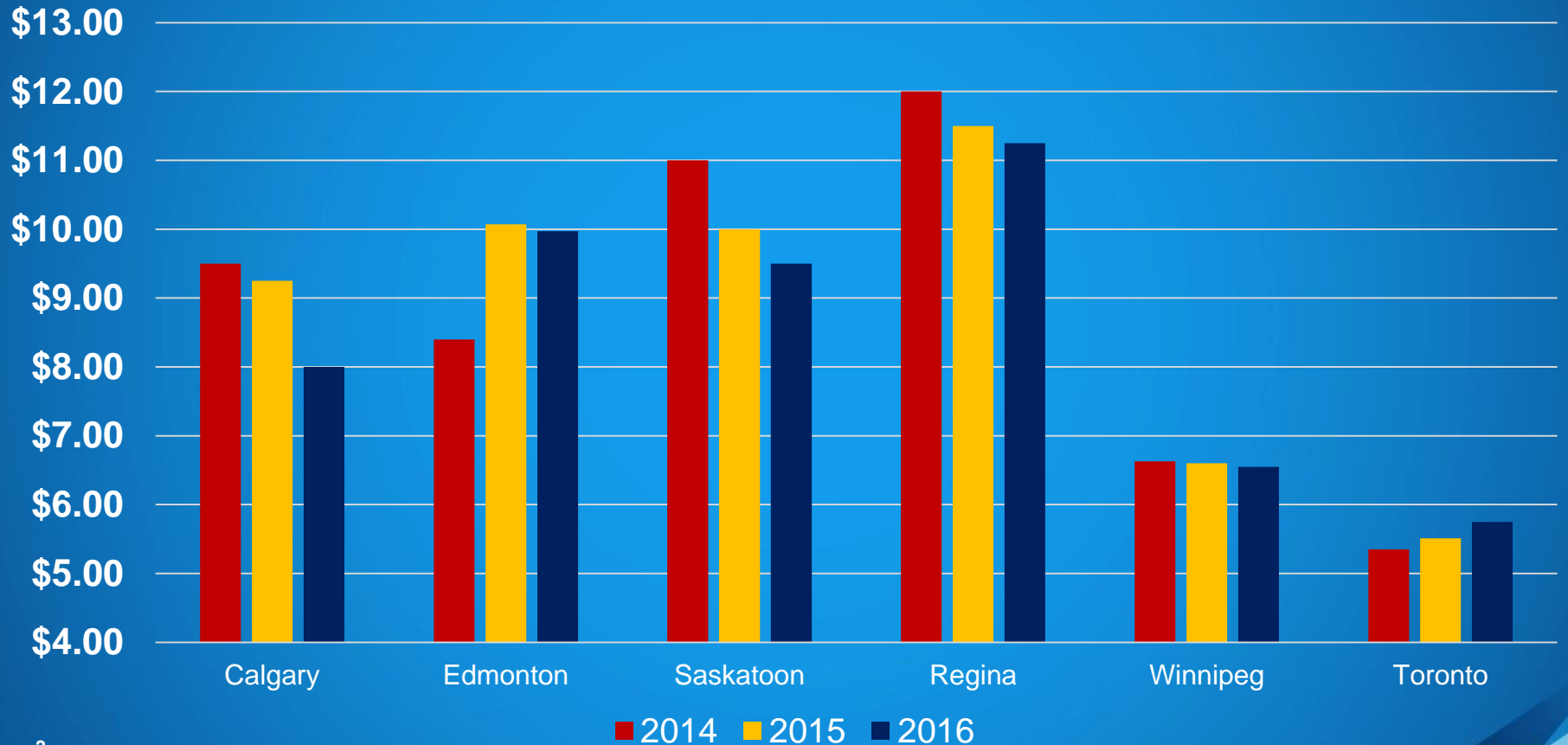


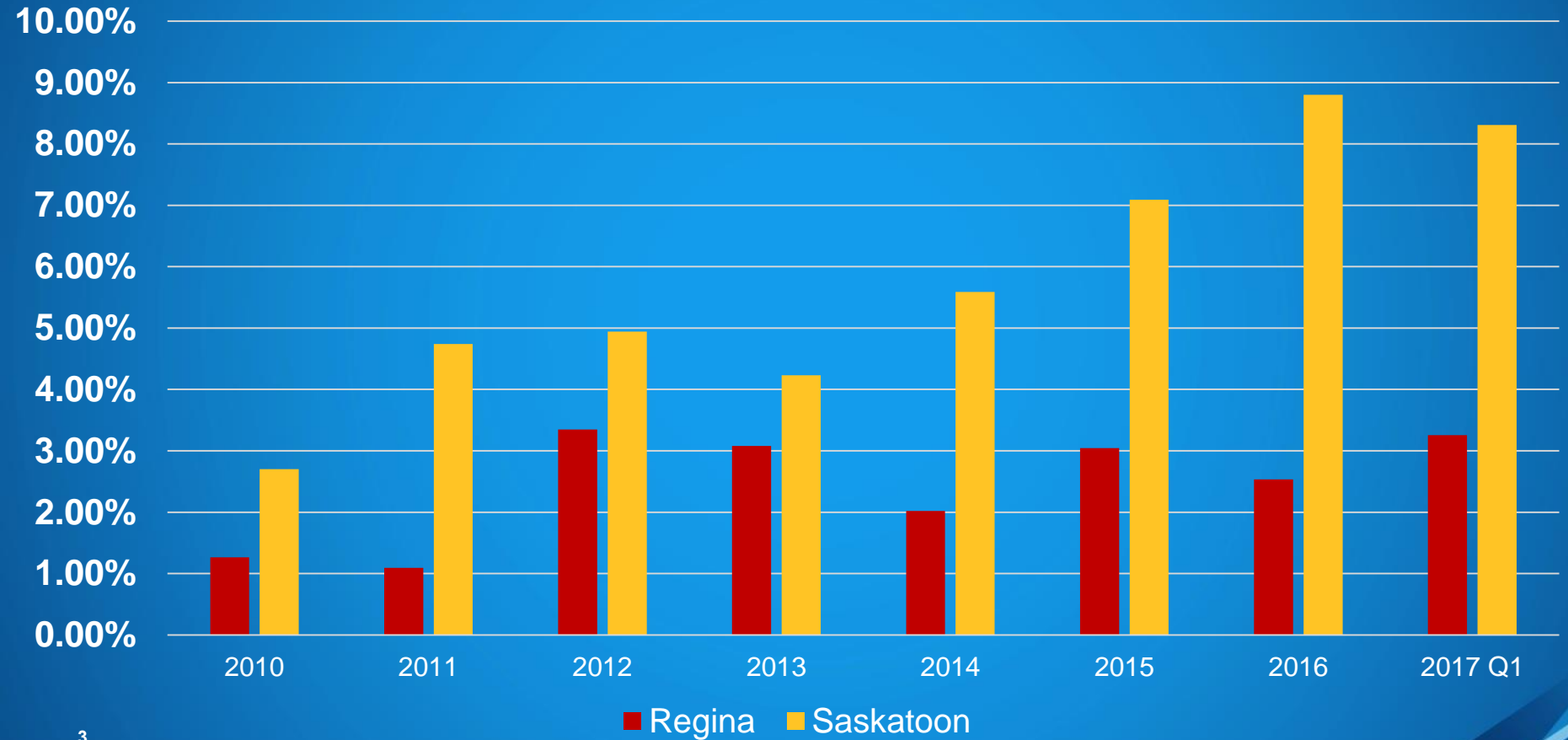
National Industrial Vacancy Rates 2016



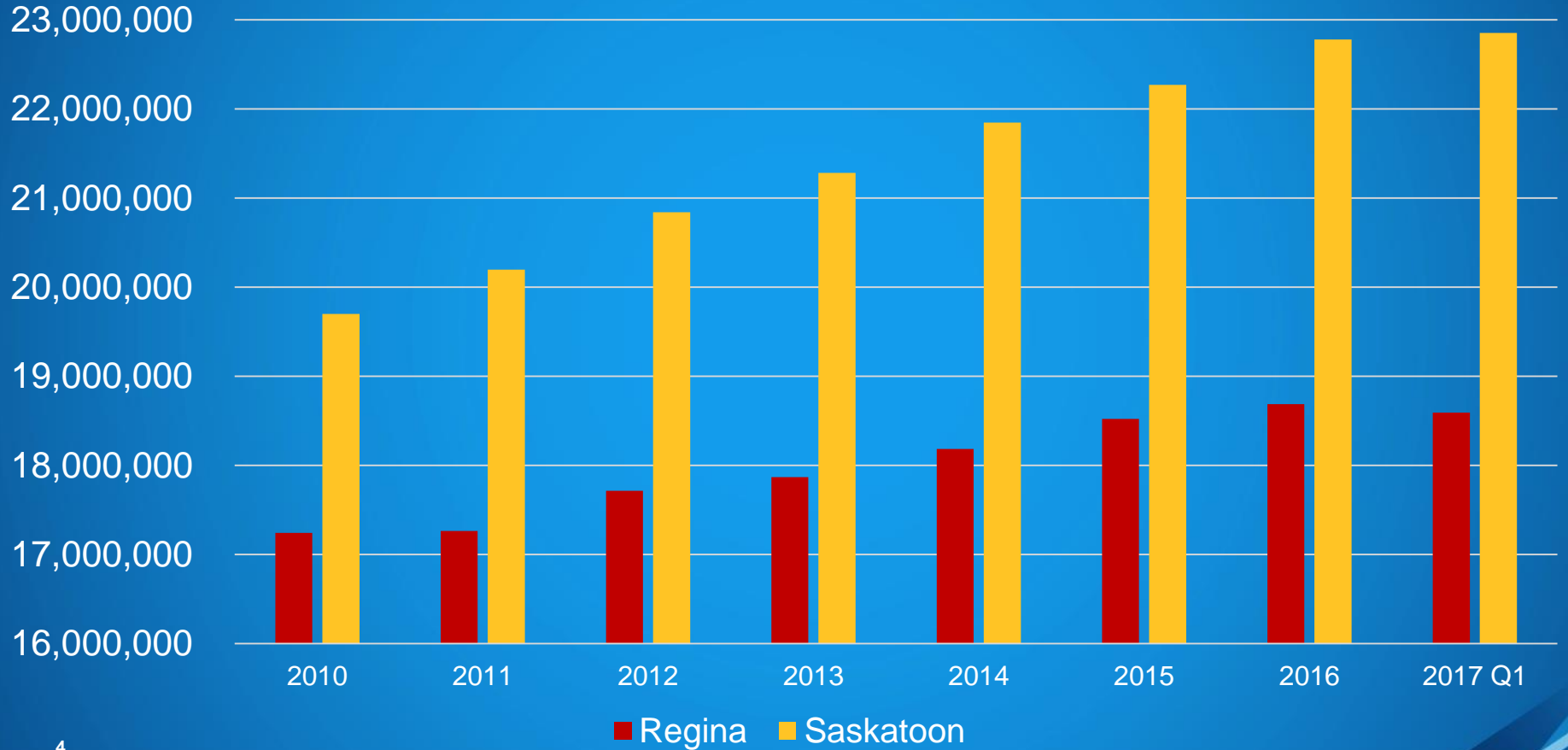
National Industrial Average Asking Rates



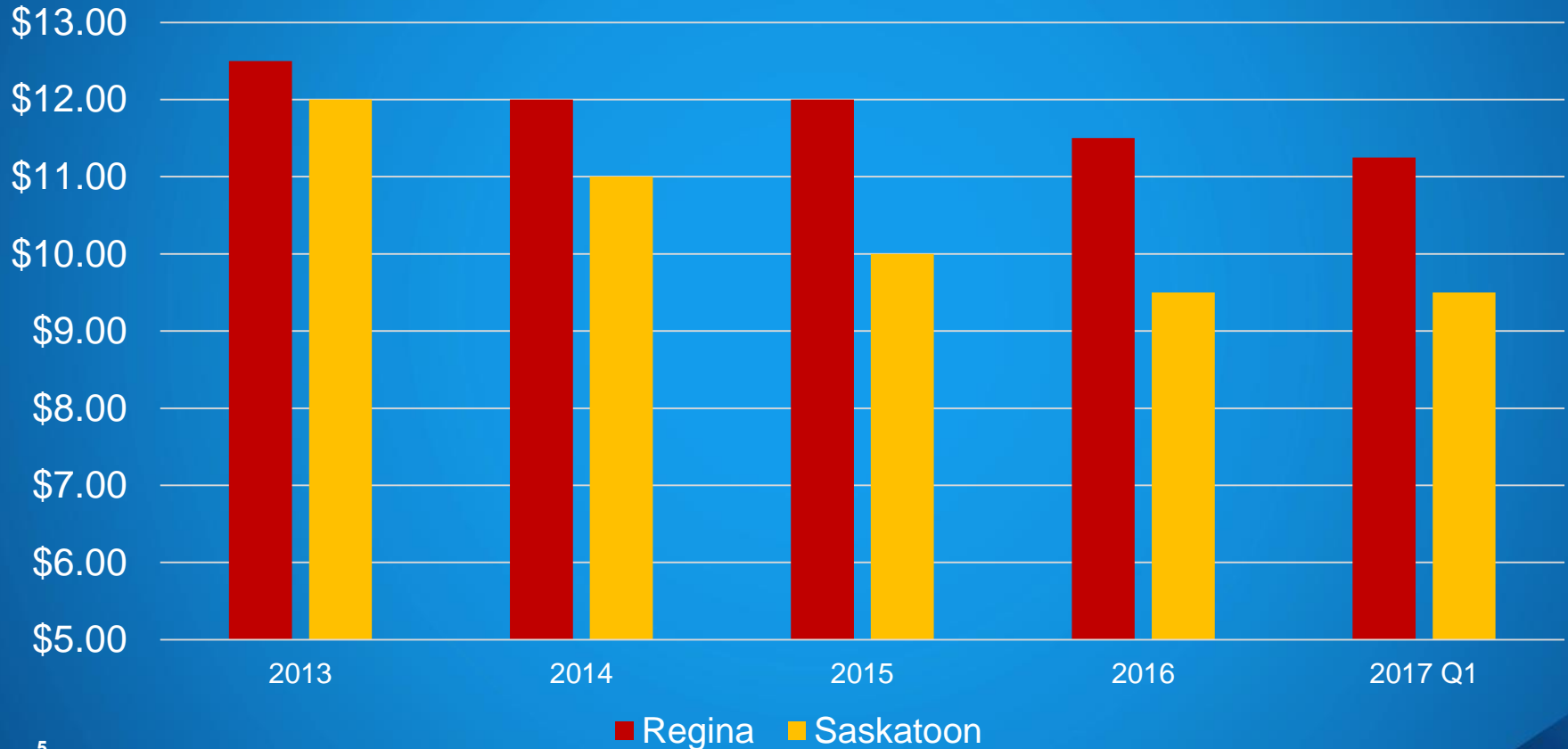

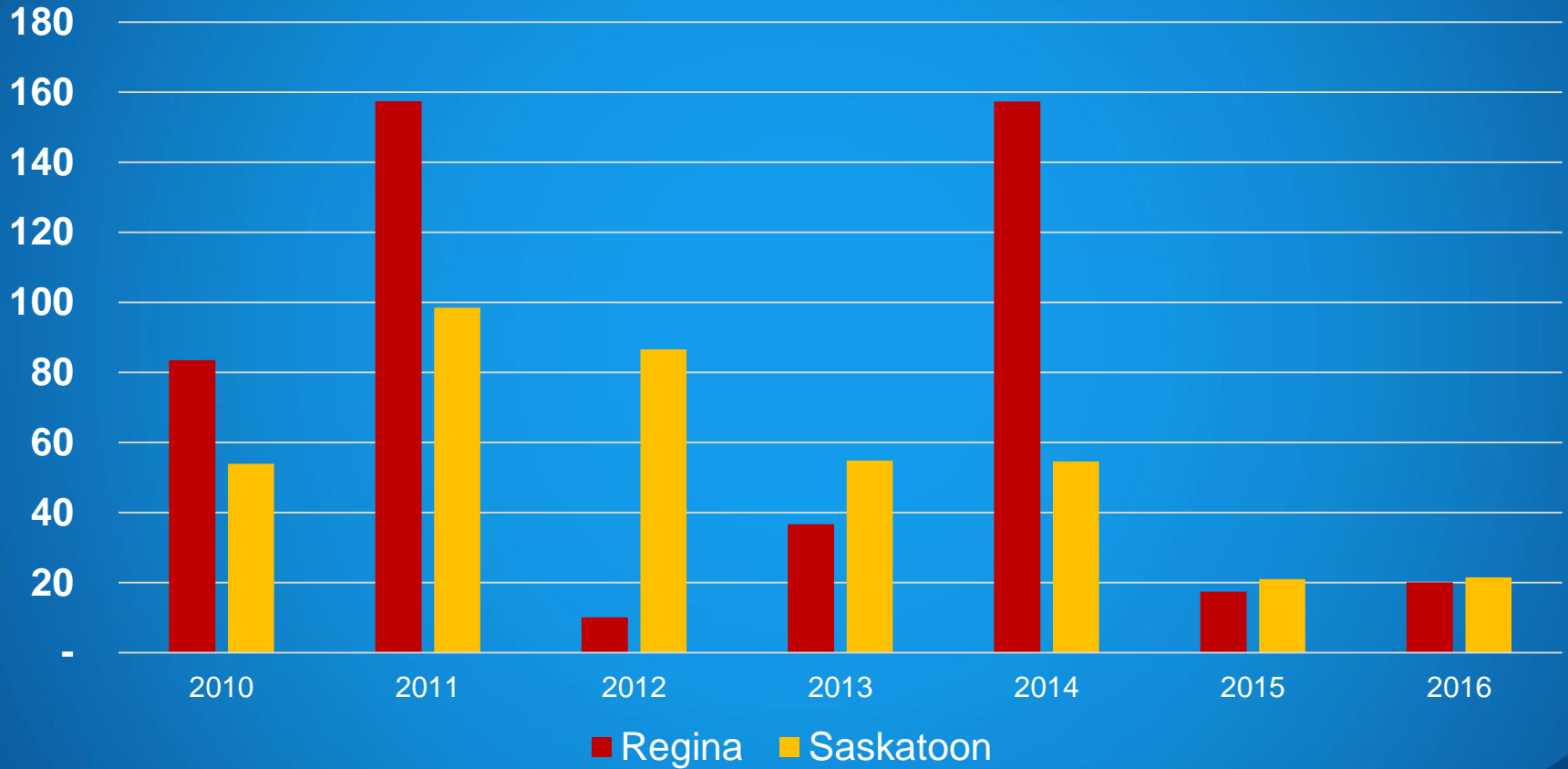
Industrial Inventory



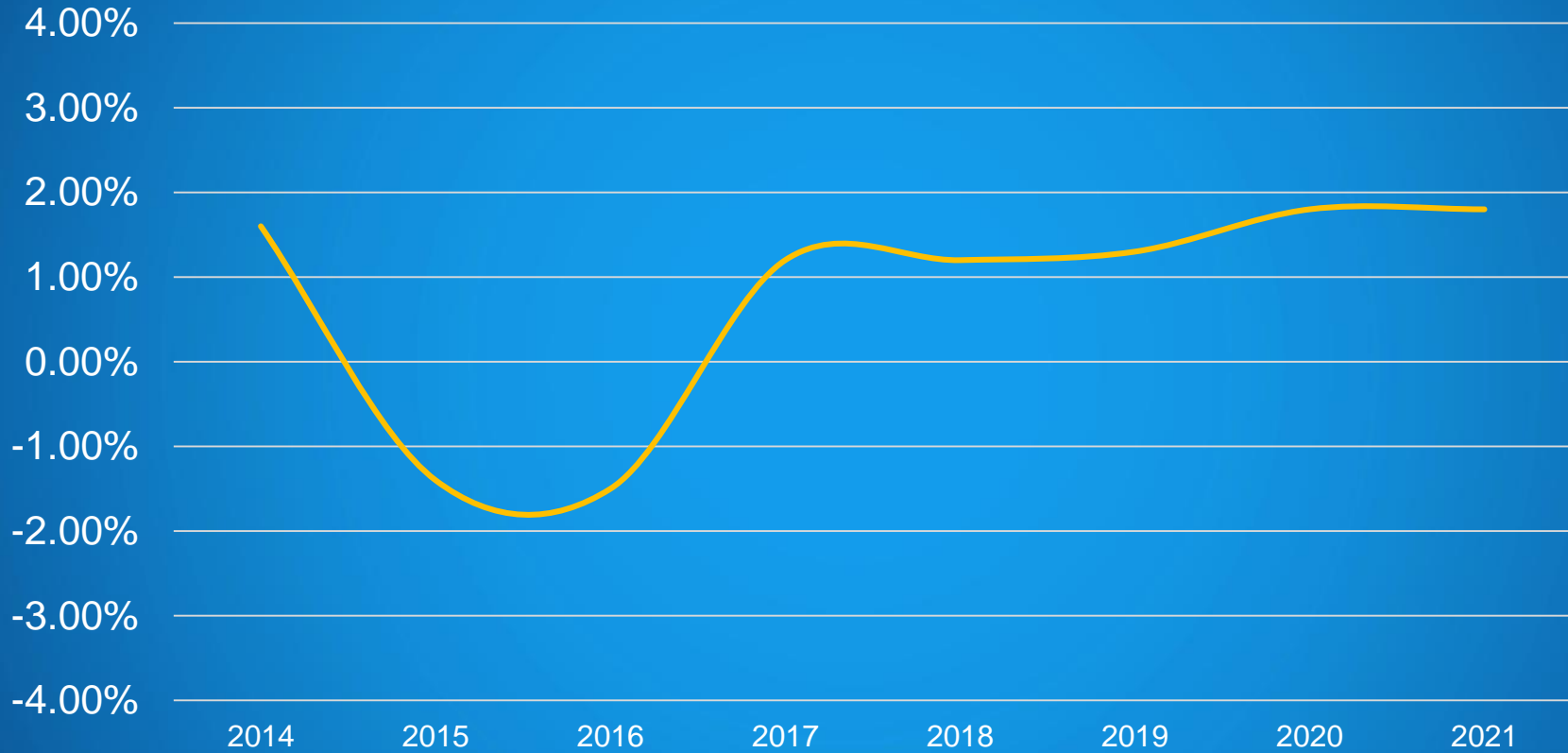
Industrial Average Asking Rental Rates
